Dear Mr. Copeland:

Thank you for your submittal of the Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality's (OKDEQ) Electronic Document Receiving System (EDRS) consolidated application, submitted under the Cross-Media Electronic Reporting Regulation (CROMERR) on September 7, 2007, and amended on June 4, 2008, for revision/modification of multiple authorized programs. EPA has reviewed your application and, as detailed and limited below, has determined that the Oklahoma EDR system complies with the requirements for electronic document receiving systems in 40 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Part 3, section 3.2000.

At this time, as provided in CROMERR section 3.1000(c), EPA approves Oklahoma's request for program modifications/revisions to allow electronic reporting, only for the following authorized programs and specific reports:

- **Program:** Part 60 Standards of Performance for New Stationary Sources; **Reports:** New Source Performance Standards Reports under section 60.7, and Continuous Emissions Monitors/Continuous Opacity Monitors under sections 60.7(c) and (d);
- **Program:** Part 61 National Emission Standards For Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP); **Report:** NESHAP Reports Notification of Start Up under section 61.09;
- **Program:** Part 63 NESHAP for Source Categories; **Reports:** Continuous Emissions Monitors/Continuous Opacity Monitors under section, 63.10(e)(3), and Maximum Achievable Control Technology Reports under section 63.9;
- **Program:** Part 70 State Operating Permit Programs; **Reports:** Annual Compliance Certifications under section 70.6, and Semi-Annual Monitoring and Deviation Reports (SAR) under section 70.6;
- **Program:** Part 122 EPA Administered Permit Programs: The National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES); **Reports:** Stormwater Notice of Intent/Notice of Termination under section 122.26, and Wastewater Daily Monitoring Reports (NPDES) under section 122.41;
- **Programs:** Part 144-148 Underground Injection Control (UIC) Program, State UIC Program Requirements, UIC Program: Criteria and Standards, State UIC Programs, and Hazardous Waste Injection Restrictions; **Report:** UIC Permit Applications;


- **Program:** Part 261 Identification And Listing Of Hazardous Waste; **Report:** Regulated Waste Activity Notification;
- **Program:** Part 270 EPA Administered Permit Programs: The Hazardous Waste Permit Program; **Report:** EPA Hazardous Waste Permit Application Part A Form (EPA Form 8700-23).

The Agency is still considering Oklahoma's request for the remaining program modifications/revisions specified in the OKDEQ EDRS consolidated application.

As provided under CROMERR section 3.1000(d), this approval is effective upon publication of a notice of this approval in the *Federal Register*.
